- All players tuck a bib (tiger tail) inside the belt of their bottoms ensuring there is a tiger's tail (not a bunnys tail)
- On coaches call player must try steel the bib from other players.
- Players are only allowed touch the tail no other part of the player.
- Play for 1 minute, player with most tails wins.
- Can do teams only get opposite colour. Player who loses tail must stand still. Player who robs tail must place in belt as another tail.
- Active team mates can rob tail back and free up still players. (older players)
